

December Mission Focus: Lottie Moon

Join the Great Pursuit and make Jesus known among the nations

WHO IS LOTTIE MOON? Lottie Moon was appointed a missionary to China July 7, 1873. She was a bold woman of action and radical obedience who shared Christ with the people of China to the end. Lottie died Dec. 24, 1912, leaving a legacy of love and service to her Lord. Her influence led to the establishment of Woman's Missionary Union and inspired other missions' pioneers to join her on the field. Her passionate letter-writing led to the offering that bears her name today, Lottie Moon Christmas Offering® for International Missions.

The Lottie Moon Christmas Offering is an annual event that honors the work of Lottie Moon, who wrote letters to the Foreign Mission Board (now International Mission Board) while living in China. The offering supports missionaries by paying for: Language studies, Travel Salaries, Food, Rent, Clothing and School for their children.
